Rolex Sydney Hobart Yacht Race 2009

Amendment 1 to the Sailing Instructions

18.1 *Delete, and insert:*

18.1 There shall be two starting lines, designated 'southern' and 'northern'. Boats shall start on the starting line allocated to them by the Race Committee. The allocation of boats to start lines shall not be subject to protest or grounds for a request for redress (amends RRS 60.1 and 62.1(a)). Start line allocations will be placed on the Official Notice Board prior to 0900 hours on 24 December 2009.

The southern starting line will be in the vicinity of Steele Point and runs approximately NW to SE.

The northern starting line will be approximately parallel to and approximately 0.2nm to the NE of the southern start line.

Each starting line will be between the mast of the respective Race Committee signal vessel (a boat displaying a white flag with black 'CYCA' lettering, anchored at the eastern end of that starting line) and a large Rolex buoy marking the western limit of that starting line.
